January Program- Astrophotography by Jim Gardepe

January's presentation will be by HPS's Jim Gardepe, a psychologist with a private solo practice, who describes himself as an enthusiastic amateur photographer with a special interest in astrophotography, especially of the Moon and of total solar eclipses. Through years of capturing solar eclipses starting in 2010, he has perfected his photography by trial and error. In his own words- "To prepare for eclipse photography, I practiced by photographing the Moon. Many of the photographic methods and processing techniques used for Moon photography are similar to those used for eclipse photography, and the general skill of handling a camera efficiently in the dark is essential to both. I have come to love learning about our companion satellite through photography. I am in constant pursuit of greater detail in my lunar images". His discussion on moon photography will answer some of the challenges of moon photography,

describe the workflow used in processing moon photos, a presentation on freeware that can be used to bring out remarkable detail in moon photos, and suggest some ways to get interesting images. The section on photographing eclipses will discuss how techniques used to photograph the moon can be adapted to the unique circumstances of total solar eclipses. He will also present an online library of resources that photographers can use to plan for photographing the "Great American Eclipse" of 2017.

Currently an honorary member of the society, he is one of our past presidents. More recently, he has helped us by judging at least one of our competitions each year.

Still living and working in Huntsville, he has freelanced as a photographer since 1985. He has a Ph.D. in pure mathematics, with particular interests in mathematical analysis and geometry. That combined with his natural love of truth and beauty provides a sound basis for his work in photography.

Muril has photographed widely across the United States, and has won numerous awards both in our local community and in national competitions.

Currently, he has over 100,000 images in stock, many of which can be seen on his commercial website - murilrobertson.com.

If you would like some idea of what Muril might be expecting in the images he sees, he has posted this paragraph on his webpage:

My goal is to make beautiful and interesting photographs of the world around us. My work varies from pristine landscapes to the whimsical. Forever searching for compositions and subjects that interest me, I strive to create images that are new to me. Yet, I must give credit to God almighty, because it is his work that I simply record and manipulate on film and pixels.

Muril judged "Letters," for us in February of 2013, "Peace/Tranquility," in February of 2014, and the first open competition in March of last year. We welcome him back this year and look forward to what he will teach us.
