-Photo Critique

If you would like helpful critique on your prints you may bring them to the Jan. 24 meeting. These can be black and white or color prints, any size from 3"x5" on up and do not have to be matted. Masters of Photography from HPS will be available to give you helpful hints. Take advantage of this session to improve your photography. We will try to have the Photo Critique session at almost every competition meeting (second Mon.) if we get a good response.

-Titles for Competition Entries

To make the Competition Secretary's job a little easier we are suggesting putting a title on each entry. If you reuse your mats you may want to temporarily affix a small blank card with the title on it. If you are feeling particularly uncreative as to what title to give your photo you can just name it "Seasons 2", Reflections 4" or whatever the topic is for that month. For slides you may either write the title on the front or fill out an index card with your name on it, the number on each of your slides and the title of each and give it to the Competition Secretary.

slide # 23 "Dead Horse Point" slide #2 "Daisies" slide #15 "Long Way Home"

slide #4 "Shadows on the Sand"

The titles of the winning slides will be read when they are presented.
