We've asked the DCNR to relook at this rule for their next contest to allow photographers to retain ownership of their images. When entering photography contests, read all rules carefully. While Outdoor Alabama is a non-profit publication seeking free images, there are other for-profit organizations that have similar contest rules, retaining ownership of submitted images.
