We'd like to thank Barry Jackson for sharing some of his images and stories of how they were captured. Many of us were familiar with some of Barry's more recent images that were consistent winners in the monthly competitions in recent years but it was especially interesting to see some of his earlier work. Barry's work in the darkroom is a marvel. Also thanks to Monica Martin for judging the Nighttime competition in July. As you can see from the results, there were lots good images in the competition.

Tom and Pat Cory from Chattanooga will be joining us again for our August program. Tom and Pat always provide an entertaining and enlightening program of images and recommendations from shooting locally in the Smokies and Cumberland Plateau, and their tours across the world. The annual Shootout will be held this month. Instructions for the Shootout, including the locations of the six topics, will be distributed at the August 9 meeting. The film will be collected at the August 23 meeting, and the results will be displayed at the September 13 meeting. Each participant must provide a roll of E-6 slide film. Anyone who is interested in judging a topic should contact Joe Boyd. Judges can participate in the Shootout, but cannot enter a topic they are judging. For those who haven't participated before, the Shootout will be 6 image topics (2 sub-topics per topic) in or very near Madison County. Each participant can shoot up to 3 exposures per sub-topic, for a total of 36 exposures, on one roll of E-6 slide film. The Society will have the film processed, the exposures judged by members of Society and a slide show will be given of the results with winners awarded in the each sub-topic.
