She has given lectures and workshops to many camera clubs; presented programs at numerous large photography conferences nationwide; and been published in several magazines (articles and cover shots). Andrea competes in and judges photography competitions locally and internationally, and has received many top awards, including PSA best of show gold medals and second place in Popular Photography's Annual Competition. She teaches photography classes in Fayetteville, Tennessee. Her interests are mostly nature-oriented, with special interests in macro, flowers, and insects (especially praying mantises). Other subjects she enjoys shooting are architecture, abstracts, and black light. Andrea also enjoys photographing in stereo (3-D).
