Wheeler Wildlife Refuge Hike

Spring has sprung and so have the spring wildflowers at Wheeler National Wildlife Refuge. An HPS field trip to Wheeler is scheduled for next Saturday, April 8th. Those who wish to meet for breakfast at McDonalds on Madison Blvd, in Madison can meet me at 6:00 a.m. Take the Wall-Triana exit off I-565 and make a right onto Madison Blvd. The McDonalds is on the right about 1/4 mile. If you come from the other direction, go about 1/2 mile past Walmart and it will be on the left side of the road. Others can meet us at the Beaverdam Boardwalk parking lot at 7:00 a.m. Get off I-565 at Wall-Triana and make a left. Go 1-1 1/2 mile to County Line Road and take a left. You will go over I-565. Take the next right. The parking lot will be at the end of this road (which parallels I-565). Meeting at 7:00 a.m. will give us two hours of good light. If it happens to be a light overcast, we will have good light as long as we stay. If rain is expected, we will go on Sunday the 9th. Currently, there are at least 8-10 species flowering and 5 or more butterfly species flying around. Of course, we usually see other interesting subjects when we are on the refuge. This will be an opportunity to take photos for the display HPS will have at the Wheeler NWR Visitors Center in late summer/early fall.
