
Larry is an author of some 27 books, 6 on Photoshop, a nationally recognized nature photographer who had 2 magazine covers to his credit last year, a certified Adobe Photoshop instructor, a recognized photo contest judge around the country, a world traveler who has been to some 117 countries, and a whole lot more.

We call his program, "An Evening with Larry" because his presentations are widely varied and often include everything from nature and fashion photography, to how to make you images "Pop" with Photoshop, to how to judge your images for competition, to any number of other topics in the Photographic field. There is never a dull moment with Larry's programs as those of you who have attended in the past will attest. His topics are often unpredictable, other than the fact that everyone will learn from his presentations! Whether you are a newbie or an old pro, you will benefit from Larry's presentation. (www.HuntsvillePhotographicSociety.org). The board has been reviewing the results and is looking into ways to improve the organization.



will download the image from the web, modify it, resize it, and email it back. I will post all responses on our digital competition website (<u>www.HPSphotos.smugmug.com</u>) along with the original image.

Questions & Answers

Q. Who can participate?

A. Any HPS member.

Q. Where will the initial/starting images come from?

A. Participants will be asked to submit one of their own images to start with. I will select from this pool of "Starting Images". Once all images have been used, I'll request another batch from the group.

Q. What format will the starting image be in? A. To ensure the best photo editing work, I would like to allow and encourage starting with RAW files. But since not all people will be able to handle all formats of RAW, I would like to have two versions of the starting file (full sized JPG and RAW). Participants can choose which they would like to use. We may also use DNG format for those that are familiar with that. The starting image will be placed on a website and users can pull down whichever format they prefer.

Q. How do I submit my modified image?

A. Images will need to be resized and saved to max size 1280 x 1024 pixels, 8 bits/channel, JPEG file and emailed to a new email address

(<u>HPSphotos@knology.net</u>). 1280 x 1024 should fill MOST monitors and allow the best evaluation of everyone's editing jobs.

Q. How many variation may I submit? A. ONE.

Q. How often will a "Starting Image" be sent out?

A. Don't know this yet? _Probably_ once a month.....initially.

Q. How soon does the modified image need to be returned?

A. 2 Weeks.

Q. Do I have to use Photoshop to edit the image?

A. NO!!! Use any and all tools that you like. Q. Am I limited on how I change the image? A.NO....with one exception. Do anything you like: crop, rotate, swirl, clone, smudge, sharpen, blur, etc. The only thing I ask is that you don't ADD items from another image.

Q. Does this affect the monthly competition in any way?

A. NO. This is purely for fun and has nothing to do with the monthly competition.

Q. Who "owns" the images?

A. Obviously the submitter of the original owns the original. The modified images are not owned by anyone. If you do the modification, you may NOT use the image in any other way without permission of the originating owner. If you own the original, you may NOT use the modified images without permission from the modifier. The originator is free to try to recreate any of the modified images him/herself. Q. What guarantees do I have about the images? A.NONE. I will put the standard disclaimers onall pages that the images cannot be used without permission. I have no way to stop theft or enforce that members follow the above rules. If an image is that important to you, don't submit it. To START:

Send email message

to <u>HPSphotos@knology.net</u>

Make subject: "PP photo sign up" I'll add you to the email list. If your submission for the starting image pool is less than 5 Meg, you can include the image in the email. If the image is larger than 5 Meg, I request that you bring the image to a regular club meeting on a CD or a thumb drive. If you are submitting a RAW or DNG file, please also create a JPG version using some basic settings so that everyone can use your image. I'll reply back with confirmation that you're on the list.

This is a very preliminary. Things may change after we start the process.

2009 Club Survey Results:

The complete survey questions and results have been posted on the club website, www.huntsvillephotographicsociety.org. The following <u>summary</u> is based on 33 responses out of approximately 103 paid memberships:

1. What are club members looking for? 88% are looking for "Learning Photography", 79% Appreciation of the Art of Photography & Competition, 39% Entertainment, & 21% had "Other" comments.

2. Program Topics:

85% want Digital Post Processing (Photoshop skills)

30% want Camera basics (f-stop, shutter speed, etc.)

33% had "Other" comments.

3. How often do you compete? 70% compete almost every month.

4. Judging Process. 82% enjoy watching the judging process, 100% want judges to comment on winners, 42% had other comments about the judging process.

5. Competition categories: 65% want to keep slides, 35% want to drop it. 100% do NOT want to combine b/w with color prints.
